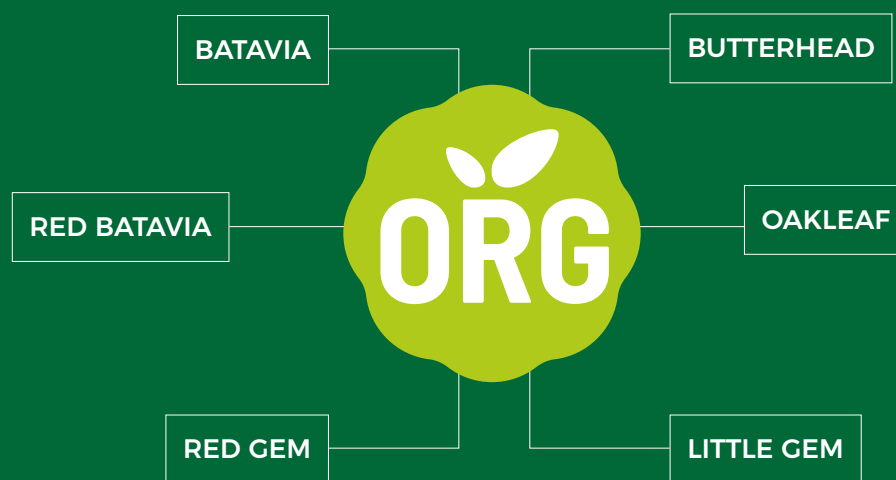
The IBEB-EU (International Bremia Evaluation Board for the EU) made official 3 new races of *Bremia lactucae*: Bl: 38EU, Bl: 39EU and Bl: 40EU. The races Bl:16-28EU are practically no longer observed in Europe. Thus, since July 1, 2023, declarations of resistance for varieties of lettuces will only carry Bl: 29-40EU.
