#### CYCLE: 75 - 85 DAYS

Suitable for autumn harvest. Very white curd without hairiness, firm and compact with a good tolerance to knocks. Healthy inner leaves, strong and tight to the curd. Uniform grade and presentation.

Good behaviour facing downy mildew. Grouped harvest.



## An outstanding foliage

#### CYCLE: 80 - 95 DAYS

- Suitable for autumn harvest.
- Round white heavy head. Dense and solid curds tolerant to knocks.
- Excellent foliage quality. Really good covering of the curd with solid inner leaves. Good behaviour against Tip Burn.

## The quality curd

#### CYCLE: 70 - 80 DAYS

For late summer and early autumn harvest. Short cycle variety. Dense, big size and very white curd. Vigorous and semi-erect plant. Grouped harvest. Can be suitable for spring cultivation.



## **PLESSI**

### For versatility, use Plessi

#### CYCLE: 75 - 85 DAYS

For late spring, summer and early autumn harvest. Short cycle variety. Dense, white and smooth curd. Vigorous plant. Dark green upright leaves that assure a good protection of the curd.

## Ideal for processing

#### CYCLE: 90 - 100 DAYS

Suitable for autumn harvest. Nice white head well-rounded and well wrapped. Dense and solid curds. Easy to cut and to pack for the fresh market. High percentage of medium size florets for processing.

## **T265 DUBROCA**

### Good tolerance to climate hazards

#### CYCLE: 100 - 120 DAYS

For late autumn harvest. Round, white and big size head. Dense, solid and heavy curds with a good tolerance to knocks. Strong and vigorous plant.



## DRAKAR

#### The one for winter

CYCLE: 130 - 150 DAYS

Suitable for early winter harvest. White curd very smooth and well covered. Upright foliage, robust and strong. Nice blue-green leaves. Homogeneous and grouped production. Good resistance to cold.
